**ATTENTION THOMSON SEWER CUSTOMERS**

*Beginning in August 2020, the Village will be starting construction on clarifier improvements at its wastewater treatment facility and on the construction of a new lift station, along with associated site restoration work.*

*The total project is estimated to cost \$1,157,891 and is being financed with 25-year 1.5% loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Water Pollution Control Loan Program (WPCLP). The Village will also be securing \$347,367 in principal loan forgiveness from IEPA. The final loan amount the Village will have to pay back is estimated at \$810,524.*

*The Water Pollution Control State Revolving Fund (SRF) is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). A portion of the IEPA money to fund these types of projects comes from the US Environmental Protection Agency. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities with the resources to build, maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.*

*The project will provide improved sewer services to the Village's users.*
